He has to clean the nastiest, most vile stall in the restroom. Seriously, people have never come back from there.

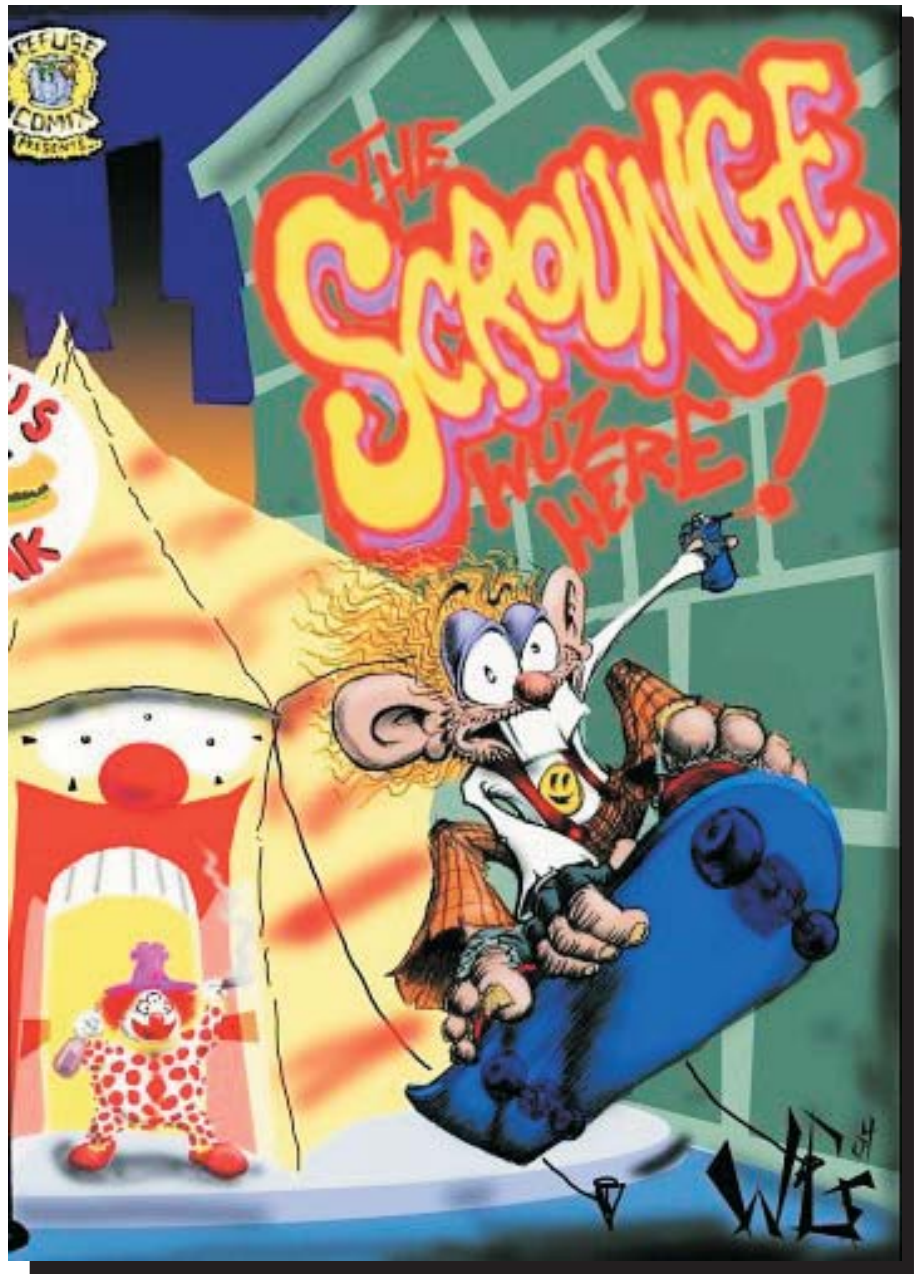
The Scrounge gets by.
